A LEADER HAS DIED

Obituary from the KansasCity Star newspaper dated December 22, 1999

William Norman Enes, age 54, Lenexa, KS, died Monday, December 20th, 1999 in London, OH. A memorial service is being planned for a later date. William (Bill) Enes was born December 23rd, 1944, in New York, the son of William Norman, Sr., and Joyce Enes. Bill has been self-employed as a antique dealer and author. He was recognized as an international authority of vintage vending machines. Survivors include his wife, Peggy, daughter, Teresa Wettengal and grandson, William Wettengal, both of Des Moines, IA; his mother, Joyce Levine, Mountain Lakes, NJ; sisters, Bonnie Morgan, Garden City, NY and Pamala Munn, San Francisco, CA ...

The obituary goes on to name additional family members and, along with them, we have to deal with the loss of a good friend as best we can. Losing a friend of 20 years is very hard for me.

Bill and I met as dealers doing the Chicagoland Show and the O'Hare Expo Center. In those early days of Chicagoland, only dealers were allowed inside on Friday. It was fun meeting and having time to get to know fellow dealers. Bill and I were usually close to each other with our booths. We had a lot of fun kidding and joking around.

When the show moved to St. Charles, our booths were side by side. They have remained side by side through this fall's show.

When Bill authored "Silent Salesman" it immediately became "The Bible" of all gum and peanut machine collector's. He was the recognized authority of collectable vending machines.

Bill expanded the hobby by starting the Philadelphia and Hackensack, New Jersey, shows. He earned a reputation as a good show promoter during those years. He participated in all the shows. He was dedicated to the coin-op hobby.

When he decided to do "Silent Salesman, Too", he asked me to be his proof reader. It was an eye opener for me to see all that is involved in bringing a book to print. Bill and Peggy were a great team. We owe a big "Thank You" to both of them.

For about the last three years, Bill had been preparing a new book on chewing gum. I hope Peggy will be able to complete this book. It would be a great tribute to him.

I think we've all lost a good friend. Bill was a friend to virtually all who came to him. He will be missed ...

Ken Rubin opened the meeting by telling the group of the passing of a long time collector, Stan Harris. Stan was a leader in the vending industry in the Philadelphia area. He was an avid collector in both the vending area and in slot machines. Stan was the original owner of the famous Fey Liberty Bell. Stan was, and will be remembered as, a tough but fair person.

The main speaker of the evening was the infamous and certainly entertaining, Bill Enes. The author of the "Silent Salesman" and the "Silent Salesman Too" Bill is sometimes referred to as the guru of vending.

Bill started off telling stories about some of his great finds. The generous man he is, he gave his parents a Columbus Machine for Christmas one year that set him back a whole \$3.00. Yes, it came from a group of 850 machines he purchased in a great find of vending from an old time operator. This find included Hamiltons, Columbus, Victors, Bluebirds, and many other machines. This find was preseded by a find of 150 Columbus Machines all with barrel locks. As Bill has said, and many other collectors agree, the time and energy you put in to finding machines will pay off in helping you discover your gold at the end of the rainbow ...

Bill then went on to show us some very unusual (and not pictured in either of his books) vending machines. The interest was overwhelming. The nice thing about this part of the meeting was to remind collectors that those unknown treasures are still out there. Keep looking and you will find !!

The excitement Bill shared is the same excitement vending collectors share with their new finds. This hobby is relatively new but the machines are very old and extremely interesting. Bill Enes may have written "The Silent Salesman, but he certainly had a lot to share and say about the hobby.

Frank DeMayo closed the meeting with an announcement letting us know that the Spring and Fall Chicagoland Shows are definitely going to be at Pheasant Run in 2000. See you at the C.O.C.A. meeting in the Spring.

FROM FRANK DEMAYO

Here's a little story about buying items outside the US.

Recently I purchased an automaton from an auction in France. Everything went smooth until the shipping part. I decided to have a shipping service box and send the item to the US. I was quoted \$1100.00 which I thought was extremely high so I tried to find someone to do it cheaper. I proceeded to contact Christian Bailly who is a well known authority on automata. He told me the price quoted was a fair price. So now it's already been a month since purchase and I proceed with the first estimate. This automata is about 3 ft. high and —ft. wide weighing about 25 lbs. They had to build a box to ship it in which took another week, and then it was shipped to Miami, FL. I then had to deal with a customs clearance company. The wooden box was now 5 ft. tall and 2 ft square and now could not be sent UPS. So I had to go air freight which cost me another \$470.00 and another week delay waiting to clear customs.

So if your purchase something from abroad - get some idea what it will cost because it can get expensive!

I could have flown to Paris, picked up the automata, taken it back to the US on the plane for about \$500.00 cost of a round trip ticket - Miami to Paris

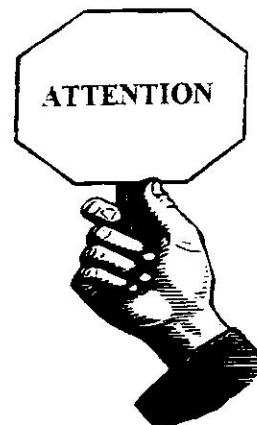

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be Coin Operated Collectors Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The location and Post Office address of its registered office is _____

ARTICLE III.

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and/or scientific purposes as defined and limited by Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), including, but not limited to:

1. The bringing together and promoting of fellowship among persons interested in coin operated machines;
2. The education of members by holding meetings, maintaining a directory of collectors, and publishing periodicals and other literature of interest to members;
3. To cooperate with other individuals and organizations by providing available educational and informational material.

ARTICLE IV.

The Executive Board of this corporation shall consist of the following Officers elected from the General Membership: President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary; and such other Officers and/or Committee Chairs as may be prescribed by the bylaws.

ARTICLE V.

All conditions, qualifications, requirements, privileges and regulations regarding membership in the corporation, including voting rights, and the number, powers, and duties of the Executive Board, shall be fixed and governed by the bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI.

The corporation is organized on a non-stock basis and has no authority to issue shares of stock.

ARTICLE VII.

If the corporation is to be dissolved, the Executive Board shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all assets in such manner, or to such organization or organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as tax exempt organizations.

Coin Operated Collectors Association

BYLAWS

ARTICLE I - Scope

All powers of the Coin Operated Collectors Association, Inc. (COCA hereinafter) conferred upon it by virtue of its incorporation shall be executed in accordance with the provisions of the bylaws.

ARTICLE II - Purpose

The purpose of COCA shall be to preserve, through research, education, and fellowship, that segment of history relating to coin operated machines; and to promote the enjoyment and growth of the hobby of collecting such machines.

ARTICLE III - Character

COCA shall be organized exclusively for charitable, educational-scientific purposes as defined and limited by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. No members of the corporation shall receive any pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, from its activities, except that the corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.

ARTICLE IV - Membership & dues

Membership in COCA shall be open to any individual interested in the hobby of collecting coin operated machines. Application for membership shall be made and confirmed annually. Classes of membership are individual, corporate and sustaining.

1. Individual memberships are extended to adults eighteen years or older.
2. Corporate memberships are extended to businesses, antique dealers or museums, historical societies, and similar entities.
3. Sustaining memberships are offered to individuals fifty years or older, who are granted lifetime membership without annual dues, for exceptional service rendered to the organization, as voted and approved by the Executive Board.

Membership fees are determined annually by the voting members, and communicated to the general membership via mail, at least ninety (90) days prior to date due. The anniversary date of membership is determined annually by the Executive Board, and applications received after this date shall be pro-rated, so as to ensure all memberships begin and end within the same period.

ARTICLE V - Duties & rights of members

Members shall be current in all dues and fees in order to be considered in good standing and thus receive the right to vote at elections and meetings, and the right to receive the COCA Newsletter and Member Directory. Members shall be prompt and fair in their dealings, so as to promote the purpose of COCA. Members whose actions are judged to be contrary to the purpose of COCA may be suspended/barrred from future membership by a two-thirds vote of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE VI - Executive Officers

Executive Board of COCA shall consist of the following Officers: President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary. The affairs of COCA shall be under the general direction of the Executive Board, the sole policy-making body, which provides for the administration, management, preservation, and protection of the property of the Incorporation.

Ex-officio members of the Executive Board may include the Past President and such other officers and/or committee members as shall be determined necessary at each annual meeting. Only members in good standing, with current membership of no less than one year prior to election, may serve in these positions.

1. The President is responsible for overall direction of the affairs of COCA, and supervises the performance of the other officers and the various committees. In addition, the President presides at elections and meetings in order to carry out the intent and purpose of COCA.
2. The Vice-President assists the President in performance of his or her duties, undertaking such other duties as may be assigned by the President, and must be prepared to function as acting President until the next election should the President be unable to continue in office for any reason. The Vice-President chairs the nominating committee.
3. The Treasurer maintains the funds of COCA, makes disbursements for such expenditures as may be authorized by the Executive Board, and provides a full accounting and financial status promptly following the close of each operating year. This financial accounting of all expenditures and receipts shall be submitted to the President, with a copy transmitted to the Editor of the Newsletter for publication each year in the annual Membership Directory of COCA.
4. The Secretary maintains records of all meetings, Executive Board meetings, and elections; undertakes such correspondence as may be necessary for the conduct or business of COCA, and assists the President in such other ways as may be directed.

If a vacancy occurs on the Executive Board, the remaining members may appoint a replacement to fill such vacancy until the next regular election. The appointed successor will serve for the remainder of the unexpired term, though such service will not count as a full term for the purposes of the four-term limitations imposed herein.

Meetings of the Executive Board shall be as called by the President and the convenience of its members and may be constructive meetings utilizing mail or telephone communications when so specified by the President. Executive Board is authorized in its discretion to approve

reimbursement for reasonable travel and actual expenses necessarily incurred by officers and committee chairs for attending meetings and other official duties as such.

ARTICLE VII - Elections

Elections of officers will be held annually each fall, with officers elected to serve one year, with a maximum of four terms. Any officer who has served four consecutive terms is not eligible for re-election to that specific office until one term has elapsed. Officers in good standing who are eligible for re-election shall be placed on the ballot automatically, without restriction.

Prior to February 15, the President shall provide to the Editor of the Newsletter the names, addresses and telephone numbers of the Nominating Committee, which consists of the Vice-President and two other members in good standing appointed by the President. The Editor will publish these, along with an invitation for interested members to contact members of this committee with suggestions for nominations.

Prior to May 1, the Vice-President shall present to the President the list of nominees decided upon by majority vote of the Nominating Committee. The President shall submit this list to the Editor of the Newsletter for publication prior to the fall meeting, reflecting the appropriate nominations for office and providing for write-in votes for alternate candidates. Such ballots shall be returned to the Secretary during the fall meeting or afterwards, by mail, for compiling.

Within 60 days after the fall meeting, the Executive Board will tabulate all the ballots postmarked as of that date and certify the results of the election. The candidate for each office receiving the most votes will be declared elected, and notified. Results of the election will be published in the next publication, and officers will take office January 1.

ARTICLE VIII - Legal principles

A quorum shall consist of a simple majority of those members in attendance. The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's rules of Order Newly Revised will govern COCA in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these bylaws.

Last fall I saw an ad for an early Oak gumball machine. But when I read the description better, my interest rose when I figured it just wasn't an Oak Acorn or Oak Victor Baby Grand. It is a nice piece but is missing a glass display. I am looking for members help to recreate the missing display.

The seller had found it in an attic of an old lady in upstate New York. If you look on page 58 of SS Too, or in For Amusement Only, page 84, there is a similar machine listed as an Exhibit Supply Bulls Eye Ballgum Vendor. However, the machine I have has a wood framed marquee that says: "Men Put penny in slot and push all the way in - look for Gum in round openings to find out what you will be. To obtain gum press handle on side."

Obviously it is some type of trade stimulator - fortune vendor. After pushing the handle the gum would bounce on some nail pegs, which you would probably see a few of, before going behind the display ending up in one of 11 round openings that would tell you what you will be.

While the cabinet and coin mechanism is the same as the two machines pictured, it has an opening at the bottom as the machine in F.A.O.

At the November, 1999 show Willie Howard told me that he thought one like that had been at a Smith auction and there was a brochure that may have a picture of the machine. Other advice I got was to make the display up - as this could be so "rare" - no one would know the difference.

I know some of you are already asking yourselves - - - No, it is not currently for sale, and I have \$350 in it.

FRANK POLK, COWBOY, CREATOR OF WESTERN ART

Frank Polk was an American original.

Mostly he was a cowboy. He busted bronses, he worked dude ranches, swilled bootleg whiskey and spent more than one night in the hoosegow.

But Polk was more than a cowboy . . he was an artist.

His wood carvings, and later his bronzes, show a scrupulous attention to the kinds of details only a cowboy would know.

The ropes on his bronzes had to have a three-strand and left-handed twist. If he noticed a flaw in his work, no matter how small, he'd rework it until it was right.

Polk stuttered all his life, but was an accomplished singer and storyteller who often spoke at dinners and banquets.

Polk had a flair for animals and trained several burros. For a time he had a singing pig and trained his spider monkey to drink coffee with him in the morning.

Polk was born near Louisville, Kentucky and shortly after World War I, his family wound up in Phoenix where Polk graduated from eighth grade. The family later moved to Mayer, where he began high school. But as he says in his book, *F-F-F-Frank Polk, An Uncommonly Frank Autobiography*, he thought that "if a guy wasn't a cowboy he just didn't amount to doodley-nothin'."

So when the family moved back to Phoenix, Polk left school and lit out for Prescott to get a job cowboyin'. The teenager was hired on the spot.

But Polk soon found out that cowboyin' was plenty of hard work and low pay but it still suited him just fine.

He rodeoed quite a bit those days, and drank more than was good for him, once riding his horse in the Palace Bar while on a toot.

Like most cowboys, he never saved a nickel. In his book, he tells about the cowboy who invested in real estate. When asked what kind of real estate, the cowboy replied .. "houses and lots - - - Houses of ill fame and lots of whiskey."

For a time Polk worked on several dude ranches around the West, taking tourists out to Rainbow Bridge and into the Grand Canyon. He used mules to pack equipment to remote locations for several movies, among them *Cimarron*, *The Rainbow Trail*, *Beau Geste*, *Rose Marie*, and *Drums along the Mohawk* and had a few bit parts in some of them.

In the late 1930's, Polk performed pretty regularly at the Fox Theatre in Phoenix.

Polk knocked around the West for a while and wound up in Reno, working as a wood carver. He carved full-sized figures - prospectors, cowboys, and other Western characters - to go around slot machines.

One he modeled after himself shown in the above picture. He never thought much of the one-armed bandits he'd carved, saying they weren't art, but today they're collector's items that fetch thousands of dollars. Around the year 1961 Polk got interested in bronzes and began

to make a name for himself.

Polk was a longtime member of the Cowboy Artists of America who insist on absolute authenticity in Western art. But even though he never even took an art lesson many artists often came to him for advice. Polk's niece recalled her colorful uncle's unpredictability....

"Uncle Frank would disappear for a year or two, then show up with a new career and a new wife. We never knew what might come through the door."

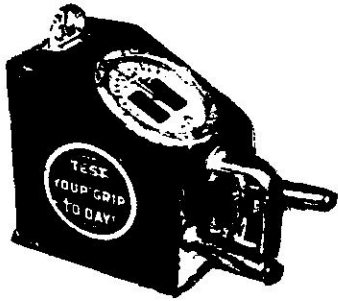
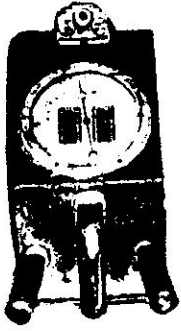
Experience had been his teacher, and Polk had absorbed many a lesson.

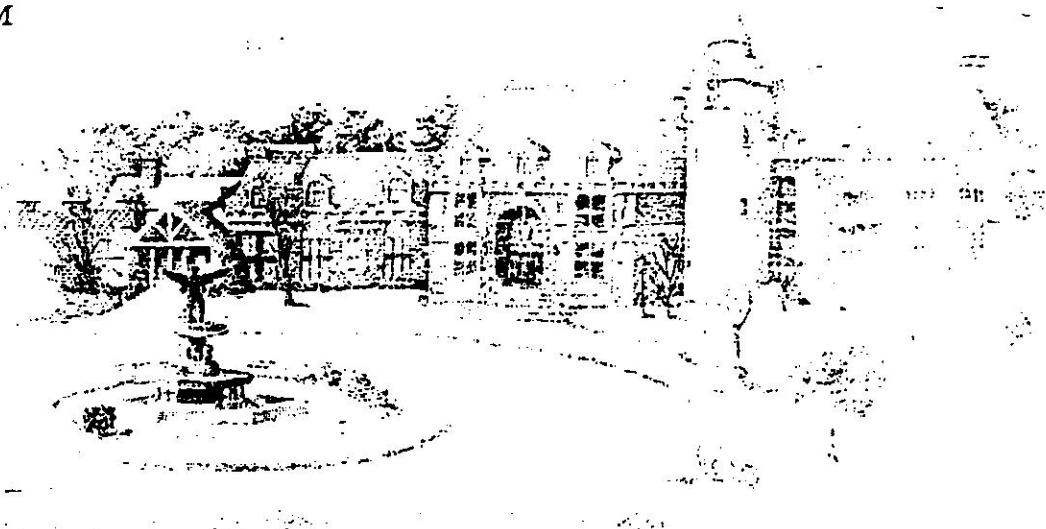

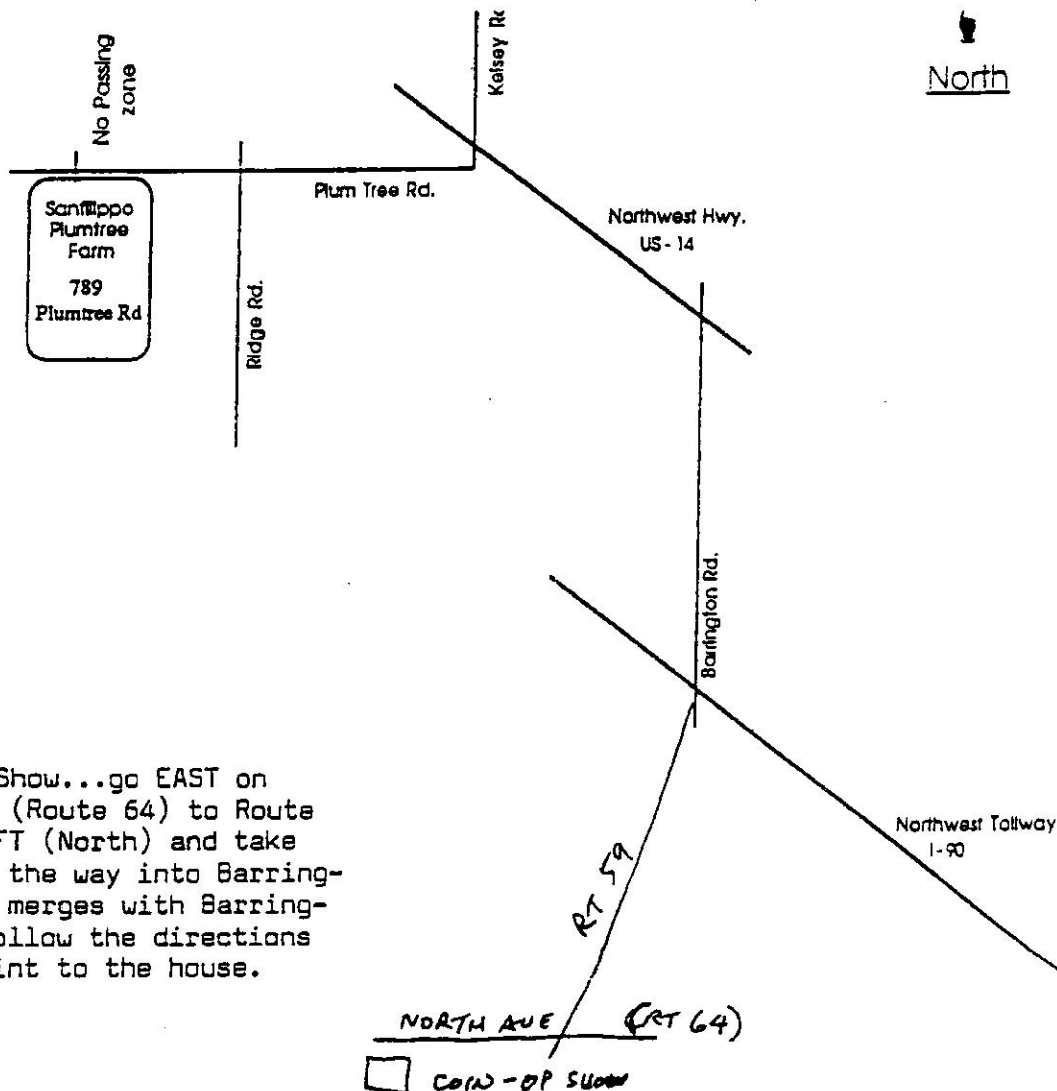

**PROPOSED BY-LAWS
OF THE
COIN OPERATED COLLECTORS' ASSOCIATION**

ARTICLE I

The **NAME** of this organization shall be the **COIN OPERATED COLLECTORS' ASSOCIATION**

ARTICLE II

The **PURPOSE** of the organization shall be to stimulate knowledge of and interest in the collection of vintage coin operated machines in order to:

- (A.) Better understand and appreciate the positive effect these machines had on our heritage and way of life.
- (B.) The bringing together and promotion of the fellowship among members interested in coin operated machines.
- (C.) The education of members through meetings and the publication of directories, periodicals and other literature to interested members.
- (D.) To cooperate with others and organizations by providing available information to them concerning these machines.
- (E.) To provide fair, ethical practices and dealings and sales within the club and the hobby.

ARTICLE III

The **MEETINGS** shall be held in April and November of each year or at other times and places to be determined by the Board of Directors. Special meetings may be called at any time and place as designated by a vote of the Board of Directors.

Notice of all such meetings as to the time and place thereof shall be mailed to members by the Secretary at least 60 days prior to general meetings and at least 30 days prior to any special meeting called by the Board of Directors.

An agenda for all meetings shall be communicated to the memberships at least 30 days prior to such meeting by the Secretary. Matters may be added to the agenda by the President or by the written request of a least four (4) members to the Secretary within 30 days of any such meeting.

ARTICLE IV

As to **PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERSHIP**, each member shall have one vote in person or by written proxy. Thirteen or more members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at all meetings. When a quorum is present, a majority of the members present in person or by proxy may decide questions brought before the meeting, except where a larger vote is required by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES .. The officers of the organization shall be the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, and such other officers as the members shall from time to time elect. The terms of the President and Vice-President shall be limited to two consecutive years. The officers shall be elected annually and shall hold office until their successors are chosen. Elections shall be held each Fall. Prior to February 15th of each election year, the President shall provide the Editor of the Newsletter with the names, addresses and telephone numbers of the Nominating Committee, which shall consist of the Vice-President and two members appointed by the President. The Editor will publish these, along with information for contacting committee members with suggestions for nominations.

Prior to May 1, the Committee will present to the President a list of nominees decided by a majority of the committee. The President shall submit this list to the Editor for publication to the members along with appropriate provisions for blank or alternate candidates. Such ballots shall be returned for tabulation prior to the Fall Meeting.

By the Fall Meeting, the Board of Directors shall tabulate the results and the candidate receiving the most votes will be declared elected.

PRESIDENT

The President shall preside over the meetings and shall act as the general management of the affairs of the organization

VICE-PRESIDENT

The Vice-President shall assist the President and shall, in the event of the absence or other inability of the President to serve, exercise the powers and perform the duties of the President. He shall also organize such committees and appoint such members and chairman of same as necessary to carry out Association Business and Policy.

SECRETARY

The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the organization and record the minutes of all proceedings. He shall also maintain a registry of all current members and give notice to members of all meetings to be held and perform other duties customary with this office. He shall also oversee and carry out all final decisions regarding any newsletters or periodicals of the organization. He shall also be responsible for providing the agenda notices prior to each meeting.

TREASURER

The Treasurer shall have custody of all organization assets, revenues and have full authority to collect dues as assessed by the organization. He shall also keep full and accurate records of receipts and expenses made by him on behalf of the organization. He shall render a report to the membership at each meeting. He shall also perform all acts and duties normally incident to this office and shall have all other powers and duties needed per the By-Laws or otherwise agreed by the members.

ARTICLE VI

DUES AND FEES

Dues and Fees shall be such as are duly determined upon by the membership from time to time, but it is the intent and purpose of the organization to continue the amount of such in the minimum amount required for necessary and essential disbursements of the organization. Because of their contributions to the organization, Frank and Gloria DeMayo shall be deemed lifetime members and shall never be required to pay annual dues.

ARTICLE VII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall consist of five (5) members of which no more than two (2) shall be "dealers", duly appointed at the annual meeting of the organization, by the President, to hold office for not more than two (2) consecutive years and shall hold office until the next board is appointed. The President shall have authority to fill vacancies resulting on the Board. The Board shall act primarily as an advisory board and shall render reports and suggestions as called upon by any duly elected officer. The Board may request money from the Treasure regarding organizaion expenses, but the Treasure shall have the right to refer any such request to the membership for action at any meeting.

ARTICLE VIII

AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws may be amended or repeated by the affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the organization present or by proxy at any regular or special meeting of the organization where a quorum is present; provided, however, that unless notice of such proposed amendment has been given a least 30 days prior to such meeting, such amendment shall require the affirmative vote of a least two thirds of the members present and voting.
