To date we have a good chance of having a ONE of two known Watling Derby's on display and I will be displaying some of my collection which will include the very first Fey Liberty Bell.





INSURANCE COVERAGE

From Randy Wellman: Regarding a conversation I had with my insurance agent (Farmers) concerning the consequences of having your slot collection stolen or destroyed by fire, etc. He assured me that if your agent says items are covered under the policy, the company must pay that claim in case of a loss. The company can sue the agent for allowing things to be covered that shouldn't have been, but that's pretty rare. He did assure me that a slot or any other antique item is treated as just another item in your home such as a peice of furniture or appliance. Say for example it is stolen. The company must find another machine for sale of like kind to determine it's value or research slot books. This is why it's very important to keep records of when and where you bought it and how much you paid for it. Personally I take pictures of all my machines and keep them in a safe place, and I also save my receipts. If you only have a couple machines they will probably be covered by your homeowners policy. But if you have an

extensive collection, your dollar amount may not be enough if you suffer a total loss, such as your house burning to the ground. It is fairly inexpensive to add a higher dollar amount coverage to your collection. It's fairly common for your policy to cover one half of the value of your home in contents. Bottom line is to check with your agent before you have a problem, not after. Not all insurance companies out there do things the same.

My insurance company (State Farm Fire Co.) confirmed that you only need to increase the "personal property" part of your regular "homeowner's policy" in line with what you value your collection at - rather than getting a special "antique" or "collectors" rider. 
" Kiss My Ass "

Perhaps the length of ownership of any machine over 70 years old, should be limited to 15 years. Thereby making it possible for more people to share the custodianship of these machines.







I received the following from a slot machine collector the other day. Let's be careful out there! I was contacted by a person who said he was the son of a deceased Los Angeles area collector whom I knew. I did not know the son however. He said he had six or seven machines that belonged to his father that he wanted to sell to pay an urgent medical bill. The machines he said he had for sale were: 25c Rol A Top, 25c Horsehead Bonus, 5c Treasury, 5c Castle Front, 25c FOK Baseball Front, And a 25c Roman Head. He wanted \$700 up front for the Rol A Top and he wanted the money sent that night Western Union. He said he wanted \$700 to \$1000 each for the rest. When I told him I could have someone at his door the next morning with cash, he said he needed the money by 5 AM, and the machines were in storage and he did not have access to them for several days.

A check showed he was not listed in the phone directory, the phone number he gave came back to a pay phone.


Background ...

Earlier this year we distributed via mail, fax, e-mail, and coin-op show handouts roughly 300 surveys to collectors and hobbyists of antique slot machines. The Survey was designed to determine, from a collector's perspective, The Most Collectiable Antique Slot Machines. Each participant was asked to list - in order of preference and without regard to value or machine denomination - the top 20 machines they would most want in a collection of antique slot machines.

Our hobby is clearly prospering and is benefiting from the information revolution, the boom in nostalgia, and an unusually robust economy. Many new collectors have discovered the allure and fun of antique slot machines. While several excellent books, web sites, and even CD's allow collectors (new and experienced) to identify machines. understand the history of the slot industry, and determine rarity and approximate value, no recent attempts exist to guage what machines are hot - and which one's are not.

We want to thank everyone who supported and participated in the Survey and genuinely hope this effort both proves interesting and benefits our hobby. We can imagine local papers or magazines running an article about our relatively unknown hobby - including picture and/or a colorful story about a particularly interesting find. 
